Clyde Township Fire Department Medical First Responder Job Description

Will respond to medical emergencies, motor vehicle accidents, missing persons calls. May respond to fire calls if directed by command staff to work only in a support capacity and will not engage in structural firefighting activities. Participate in community education and training. Maintain the fire station and all medical equipment and apparatus. Response to alarms will be on a per call, per hour basis.

Essential Functions

- 1. Respond to alarms that require medical assistance and provide that assistance.
- 2. Be trained and knowledgeable in the use of all medical equipment carried on apparatus.
- 3. Be knowledgeable of all state laws and local protocols that govern EMS in St. Clair County.
- 4. Participate in fire station housekeeping.
- 5. Maintain all medical equipment on the apparatus with regard to expiration dates and use guidelines.
- 6. Attend special instruction training when required.
- 7. Participate in monthly training, meetings, and work details.
- 8. Other tasks as directed by command staff.

Training

- 1. High School Diploma or equivalent and be 18 years of age.
- 2. CPR/AED
- 3. Medical First Responder License.

Ability to:

- 1. Work under strict order discipline and follow orders.
- 2. Demonstrate and use all medical equipment.
- 3. Read and understand technical manuals in operation of equipment.
- 4. Maintain continuing education credits.
- 5. Think and act quickly in changing emergency situations.

- 6. Work in adverse locations and weather conditions.
- 7. Understand and perform oral and written directions promptly and accurately.
- 8. Perform heavy lifting and physical maneuvering.
- 9. Establish and maintain effective working relationships with those connected in the course of work.
- 10. Communicate well with others.
- 11. Attend training, meetings, and work details.
